

My Sleep Study Visit

My grown-up will stay in the room with me.




They will sleep in a bed that looks like this.




I will get ready for bed by putting on my pajamas, going to the bathroom, and brushing my teeth.

The sleep tech will talk with my grown-up for a few minutes. I can ask questions if I want.




I will even get my own prizes in the morning for doing such a good job!

The sleep tech will put one belt around my chest and one around my belly.




Then, the sleep tech will wrap my head and use soft tape to help everything stay in place all night. I will relax and be calm.

I will hear my sleep tech talking through a speaker.


They will ask me to do silly things like look up and down or wiggle my feet. It's OK to laugh.
